- The Bachelor's in IT program uses hands-on learning in preparing over 350 students each semester to:
  - Apply technology innovatively

- College of Information students were the first group on campus to prepare Interactive Résumés for employment. Each student registers a domain name and builds a portfolio that includes:

- The IT Program trains students in four key areas:

  - System administration

- Students in the IT Program launched an FSU chapter of the Association of IT Professionals (AITP) in the Fall of 2007. The FSU chapter boasts a membership of 150 students who participate in internships, networking events, professional development, and mentoring.
- IT students participate in the STARS Alliance program, funded by the National Science Foundation, which seeks to increase the participation of under-represented groups (women, minorities, and those with disabilities) in the computing disciplines.
